Second Confirmed COVID-19 Case at F.E. Warren Air Force Base

FRANCIS E. WARREN AIR FORCE BASE, Wyo. — There is a second confirmed, positive case of COVID-19 at F.E. Warren Air Force Base, Wyoming. The case was confirmed March 26, 2020, and involves an adult, military member assigned to the base.

F.E. Warren leadership is actively monitoring the situation and the base's public health office is taking action to properly isolate the individual in accordance with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines. The 90th Medical Group is also conducting contact tracing to discover and inform those who may have interacted with the affected member.

F.E. Warren AFB remains at Health Protection Condition Charlie. Social distancing remains imperative and personnel must comply with isolation and quarantine instructions.
