SUBJECT: Environmental Commitment Statement for F. E. Warren Air Force Base

1. This memorandum highlights Air Force Instruction (AFI) 32-7001, *Environmental Management*, which directs the Air Force to establish an Environmental Management System (EMS) at its bases.
2. The 90th Missile Wing is dedicated to protecting the environment while fulfilling its mission to "Defend America with the world's premier combat-ready ICBM force." Every military member, civilian and contract employee on the base shall actively implement the EMS.
3. To ensure the success of the EMS, we will seek to:
  - a. Promote energy efficiency and the conservation and sustainable use of natural resources and manmade materials;
  - b. Prevent environmental pollution and minimize solid and hazardous waste, emphasizing recycling and product substitution;
  - c. Build communication of environmental information into all levels of management to ensure compliance with all federal, state, local and Air Force environmental laws and regulations;
  - d. Work in partnership with all stakeholders to promote good stewardship and cooperation with base personnel, contractors, the community and regulatory agencies.
4. A Cross Functional Team will periodically review, audit and update the EMS to ensure its continual improvement and appropriateness. The review includes the environmental objectives and targets identified in the EMS and other policies.
