SUBJECT: F. E. Warren AFB Installation Tobacco Policy

1. The defense of our nation relies on the health, welfare, and physical fitness of our entire population, both military and civilian. Air Force tobacco use policies are intended to protect everyone from the negative effects of tobacco use and the harmful effects of second hand smoke. Additionally, these policies set stringent criteria for areas where tobacco use is permitted, and the historic layout of the installation makes establishment of AFI-compliant designated tobacco areas a significant challenge. As a result, F. E. Warren AFB is designated a limited tobacco-free installation. The only designated tobacco areas (DTAs) on F. E. Warren AFB are in privately owned vehicles (POVs), family housing, and the Defense Commissary outdoor break area. The medical campus and Weapons Storage Area are completely tobacco free to include no use of tobacco in POVs. DTAs at Launch Facilities and Missile Alert Facilities are governed in accordance with weapon system and other Air Force technical directives, instructions and safety.
2. Per AFI 40-102, *Tobacco Free Living*, tobacco includes, but is not limited to the following: cigars, cigarettes, electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), stem pipes, water pipes, hookahs, vaporizers, and smokeless products that are chewed, dipped, or sniffed.
3. We know personnel who use tobacco may find it difficult to stop. For that reason, we will have a 6-month transition period from the date of this memorandum before policy enforcement begins. This will give personnel time if they wish to stop using tobacco products. Individuals who wish to stop using tobacco products are encouraged to discuss options with their Health Care Provider. The 90th Medical Group team is ready to assist and offers tobacco cessation classes in support of the missile wing family as we transition to a tobacco-free installation.

Approved Designated Tobacco Use Areas (DTAs)

Per AFI 40-102, *Tobacco Free Living*, tobacco includes, but is not limited to the following: cigars, cigarettes, electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), stem pipes, water pipes, hookahs, vaporizers, and smokeless products that are chewed, dipped, or sniffed.

Per the installation commander and in accordance with AFI 40-102, *Tobacco Free Living*, dated 4 March 2015, the following areas are approved DTAs:

1. Privately Owned Vehicles (POVs) with the exception of the medical campus and Weapons Storage Area
2. Family Housing
3. DECA Outdoor Break Area
